_____ 1. I have been advised that vehicles are placed on board Bimini Shipping Cargo Vessels on a space available basis.

Initials I understand that, depending upon the volume of the cargo received by Bimini Shipping for shipment, there may be a delay of several weeks before this shipment will arrive at the Port of Discharge or Destination.

_____ 2. I understand that after a vehicle has been received, Bimini Shipping is not liable for unforeseen
Initials mechanical failure such as dead battery, flat tires, etc. The vehicle will be classified as "Non-Operable" condition requiring mechanical lifting into a container. I understand that an additional fee of \$50.00 must be paid to Bimini Shipping at time of delivery for all non-runners. Vehicles will be considered Non-operable including the following reasons:

Cracked or damaged windshields or windows, flat or damaged tires, leaking fluids, deployed airbags, unable to stay running on its own. Non- Operable vehicles will be loaded into a container with the use of a forklift, and a Hold Harmless Waiver must be signed before vehicle will be shipped.

_____ 3. I state that, for the shipper's export declaration (SED) purposes (as shipper or agent for the shipper and/or
Initials consignee), the value of this shipment is \$_____ in US Dollars. I understand that this value declaration does not infer or confer responsibility on the part of Bimini Shipping to provide marine insurance for this shipment.

_____ 4. I declare that no fuel tank on this vehicle is more than 1/4 full as per 49CFR176.905.

Initials 5. Any and All claims must be reported at time of picking up the vehicle. Bimini Shipping will not accept liability for any electrical and/or mechanical problems of your vehicle.

_____ 6. Bimini Shipping will not pay out of pocket expenses related to any delays in the shipment or arrival

_____ 7. There are no items allowed to be shipped inside vehicles being exported with exception of the
Initials vehicles own emergency equipment such as spare tire, jack, first aid kit. This includes the trunk and bed of pick up trucks.

_____ 8. The owner of the vehicle must sign a Power of Attorney\ Vehicle Export Authorization in order for the
Initials carrier to act on their behalf with U.S. Customs.

If vehicle belongs to a company, the person signing this document must also provide a letter on company letterhead stating that they are an officer of the company and are authorized to sign this document.
